4th Annual Golden Harvest Parade Line Up Map



### PARADE ROUTE

The parade starts on 9<sup>th</sup>/N St, turns left on North Capitol Mall, U-turns on 6<sup>th</sup> St. to South Capitol Mall, right turns to 9<sup>th</sup> St, and ends on 10<sup>th</sup> St.



# PARADE GUIDELINES

## Eligibility

Any organization or group representing its community or culture is eligible.

## Safety

Safety is the priority of the parade, everyone should abide by Sacramento Safety Guidelines, NO sharp equipment, fireworks, or anything that may hurt others are allowed in the parade.

## Requirements

1. Float/Vehicle/Trailer  
All float/vehicles/trailers must be LESS than 40ft L, 10ft W, and 13.5 H.  
All float/vehicles/trailers must have insurance.  
All drivers must have a driver's license.
2. Waivers  
All group leaders need to sign a Participant Waiver/Release Form.  
All Parents or Guardians of underage 18 group leaders need to sign the Minor Participant Waiver/Release Form.
3. Marching Group  
The minimum number of people in the marching group is 20 and the maximum is 300.
4. Motorcycle Group -the minimum number of motorcycles in motorcycle group is 10.
5. Application submission deadline is Oct. 21, 2025.

## Restrictions

1. All entrants must obey all requirements, procedures, and guidelines of the Parade, failure to comply with the Parade Guidelines may result in your removal from the parade and prohibition from future participation.
2. All entries must wear apparel suitable for all ages, the organizer reserves the right to exclude any inappropriate immediately from the parade.
3. All entries must not throw any items as they travel along the parade route.
4. All participants are prohibited from engaging in any inappropriate language and activities.
